LEADLINE DIVISION

AHS Points in Class #1

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per class

Open to children six (6) or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. May be asked to trot. Not eligible for any other classes.

1. AHS Leadline
2. Advanced Leadline – may be asked to trot or answer simple questions
3. Off Leaders – handler to stay with rider

MINI STIRRUP DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to riders eight (8) and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at this same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

4. Mini Stirrup Walk Trot Equitation
5. Mini Stirrup Pleasure
6. Mini Stirrup Figure 8 Equitation
7. Mini Stirrup Equitation Cavaletti Poles – 4 on the outside track

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Juniors ten (10) and under who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Open to horses and ponies. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount.

9. Short Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter
10. Short Stirrup Equitation Fences - 4 fences
11. Short Stirrup Equitation Fences - 8 fences

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Junior riders who have not shown in more than 8 horse shows in any one year. Riders can not jump more than 2' in any horse show and may only cross enter into Junior Modified Hunter. Division will be split if entries warrant. Fences not to exceed 2'. It is hoped that people will use discretion when entering and be mindful of the spirit of this division.

LESSON MOUNT DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to all riders on horses and ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount. May use any tack used in a schooling program.

18. Lesson Mount Walk Trot Individual Canter
19. Lesson Mount Over Cavaletti Poles - 4 on the outside track

PLEASURE DIVISION

AHS Points in Class #22

Open to any type of horse or pony suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going, and soundness. No martingales.

21. Cross Country Pleasure - may be asked to trot a cavaletti pole

MODIFIED HUNTER DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'6" in any show. Fences to be 2'. Will be split into Junior and Adult Sections if entries warrant.

JUNIOR EQUITATION DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Junior riders. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. S/M ponies at 2'3", Lg ponies at 2'6", and horses to jump 2'9". May not cross enter into PreChildren's Equitation.

PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to junior riders who have not won three or more blue ribbons in horsemanship over fences at any USEF rated show, except Mini Stirrup, Short Stirrup, or Beginner Equitation. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Ponies to jump 2' and horses to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Junior Equitation.

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders who have not won three or more blue ribbons in horsemanship over fences at any USEF rated show, except Mini Stirrup, Short Stirrup and Beginner Equitation. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and soundness. Ponies to jump 2', horses 2'6".

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entries can be made by mail, phone or Fax. Post entries will be accepted but pre-entries will be most appreciated.
2. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
3. The Worcester Stables Horse Show, Worcester Stables Inc., Jack or Katie Benson, or the Committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
4. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
5. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
6. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
8. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
9. Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office.
10. All pets must be leashed.
11. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
12. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks.

FROM THE NORTH WEST NJ: Take Rt. 202 South, turn right onto Rt. 73 West, turn left onto Berks road to end, turn left to the farm on the left

FROM PHILA: Rt. 76 West to Plymouth Mtg., (Exit #333) getting on Rt. 476 to Germantown Pike West. Stay on the Germantown Pike and once you pass THROUGH the intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to turn right onto Potshop Road, follow to end, turn left and make a quick right to the farm on the right

FROM KING OF PRUSSIA: Take 422 West to the Trooper/Audubon exit, follow to the Germantown Pike turn right, next light Potshop Road turn left, follow to end, turn left and then a quick right to the farm on the right

FROM PA TNPK: Exit #333 for Norristown, follow signs for Plymouth Rd., left at light, go 300 yds to make right onto Germantown Pike West, follow to intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to make a right onto Potshop Rd., follow to end, make left and quick right to the farm on the right

PRELIMINARY ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

AHS Points

Open to Adult Amateur riders on either ponies or horses. Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup Divisions at the same show.

High: 2'6" and 3' at the rider's discretion
