

GENERAL INFORMATION

Rules and Regulations: Entry fee \$20/class until 12 noon on Saturday before the show. Post Entries \$22/class.

1. Neither the horse show committee, Associated Horse Shows, nor Julie Veneziale, nor Three's A Charm Farm will be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel if necessary. We will try to accommodate everyone as possible.
3. Any person or horse suspended from USEF will not be permitted to participate in an Associated Horse Show as owner, trainer or rider.
4. Classes for junior riders will be limited to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1, 2021.
5. ASTM/SEI Approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders when mounted.
6. Six ribbons awarded in each class, champion and reserve awarded in all divisions with 3 or more entries.
7. The decision of the judge is final.
8. Schooling permitted until 7:45 AM
9. Martingales not permitted in under saddle classes.
10. Fence heights are approximate.
11. For your own safety, schooling may be regulated by show management.
12. The classes and divisions of this show will follow the specs and format of the Associated Horse Shows, including on line registration.

CLASS DESCRIPTION

High Schooling Hunter

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2'6 or 3' at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form. A division with two (2) entries may be combined with Low Schooling Hunter. Decision to be made before division begins.

Thoroughbred Hunter

Open to all thoroughbred horses/ponies that are full TBs. Judged on performance, way of going and suitability of mount to rider. Fences to be 2'3" or 2'9" at rider's discretion. **Not to be combined with any other division.**

Low Schooling Hunter

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2' or 2'3 at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form. A division with two (2) entries may be combined with High Schooling Hunter. Decision to be made before division begins.

Pre-Children's Hunter

Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and soundness. Ponies to jump 2', horses 2'6". May be combined with Pre-Adult Hunter.

Pre-Adult Hunter

Open to amateur riders on horses and ponies. Riders may not cross Enter into Modified Hunter of Long Stirrup Hunter Divisions at the same show. Fences 2'6"

Leadline

Open to children six (6) years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Not eligible for any other classes.

Mini Stirrup

AHS points Open to juniors eight (8) years and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at the same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class. Poles or cross rails must be specified on prize list.

Walk-Trot

Open to juniors and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping class at this same show.

Short Stirrup Equitation

Open to children 12 years of age & younger, who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Open to horses & ponies.

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combination may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Pleasure at the same show.

Novice Equitation

Open to junior or adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fences classes and one flat class. Fences 2' or 2'3" at rider's discretion.

Open Equitation

Open to junior or adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fences classes and o

Beginner Equitation

Open to junior riders who have not shown in more than 8 shows in any one year. Rider's may not jump more than 2' in any horse show, and may only cross enter into Modified Hunter.

Long Stirrup Equitation

Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter.

Pleasure Division

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.

Developing Hunter

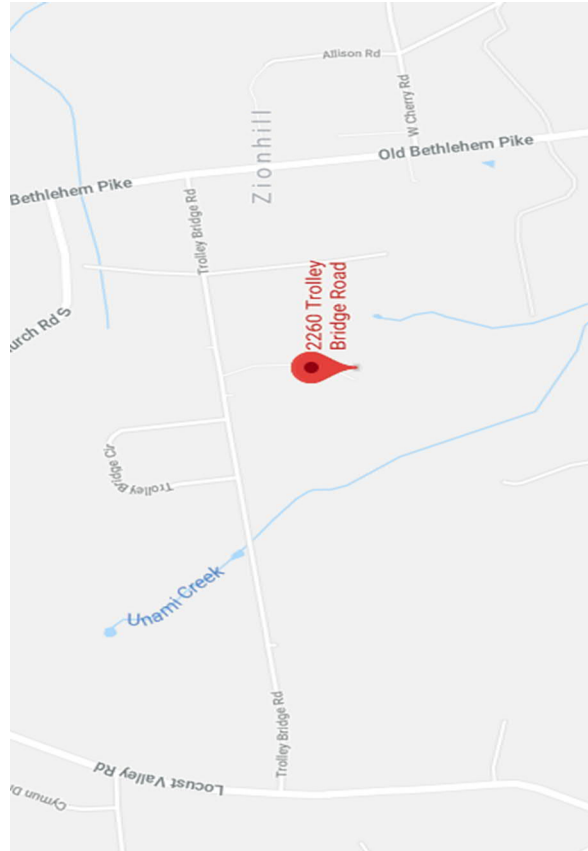
Open to horses and ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Trotting corners not penalized. To jump a simple cross rail course. May cross enter into BABY GREEN.

Baby Green Hunter

Open to horses/ponies in their 1st or 2nd year showing over fences. Ponies to jump 2' and horses 2'3. Trotting corners will not be penalized.

Modified Hunter

Open to all Junior and Adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq, 2' Eq, or pleasure at same show. Fences to be at 2'. Horse and rider combination may not compete in this division for more than 2 years. Simple changes will not be penalized
