Champion & Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division.

Rider's age is as of Dec. 1st of the current show year.

Anyone or any horse suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to exhibit in an AHS show.

The Horse Show Committee has the right to cancel, combine, or vary the order of the classes.

Three (3) exhibitors must compete in order for a Division to run with full points. If a Division has less than three (3) entries it will be combined with another designated Division. If that is not possible, the division will run with two (2) exhibitors and half points will be given towards year end awards.

ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders when mounted on a horse.

AHS registrations for horse, rider, and owner must be paid by the end of the show day in order for points from that show to count towards year end awards.

CLASS & DIVISION SPECS

HALLOWEEN LEAD LINE

Open to riders aged 6 years and under. Judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Judged 75% costume and 25% as a pleasure mount. Will not be asked to trot.

HALLOWEEN WALK/TROT/PLEASURE

Open to adults and juniors on horses and ponies. Judged 75% costume and 25% as a pleasure mount.

HALLOWEEN JUMPING

Open to adults and juniors on horses and ponies. To compete over a simple course of 4 cross rails. Rider and/or mount to be in costume. Judged 75% costume and 25% hunter.

LEADLINE DIVISION

Open to riders aged 6 years and under. Judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Not eligible for any other non-Leadline classes. Will be asked to trot.

MINI-STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to children 8 years of age and under. May not cross enter into any jumping classes. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

LESSON MOUNT DIVISION

Open to riders on horses/ponies that are solely used in a lesson program. Rider not to have competed higher than X rails at any show. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. May use any tack used in lesson program.

WALK/TROT DIVISION

Open to BEGINNER Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes.

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to all juniors who have not shown in more than eight (8) horse shows in any one year. The division will include a walk/trot; walk/trot/canter and a choice of one (1) or two (2) jumping classes of 4-8 fences at x-rails. Riders cannot jump more than 2' in any horse show and may only cross enter into Modified Hunter. It is hoped that people will use discretion when entering and be mindful of the spirit of this division. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Long Stirrup Equitation.

LONG STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Modified Hunter. Recommended classes: equitation walk/trot; equitation walk/trot/canter; and equitation over four (4) cross rails or poles. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Beginner Equitation.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to children twelve (12) years of age and under on horses and ponies who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. Recommended classes; 1. walk/trot; 2. walk/trot/canter; and 3. A simple course of 4-8 cross rails at 18".

CLASS & DIVISION SPECS - continued

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combo may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Pleasure at the same show.

MODIFIED EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Modified Hunter and Pleasure at same show. Simple changes NOT to be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'. Rider may not ride in division for more than two (2) years.

MODIFIED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all Junior and Adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Modified Equitation & Pleasure at same show. Simple changes NOT to be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'. Horse and rider combination may not ride in division for more than two (2) years.

PLEASURE HUNTER

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a Junior or Adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.

DEVELOPING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Trotting corners not penalized. To jump simple cross rail courses. May cross enter into Baby Green

BABY GREEN HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

LOW JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. May not cross enter into any Children/Adult Hunter classes on same mount. Fences 2' or 2'6" at riders discretion. Simple changes not to be penalized.

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all horses or ponies that are full Thoroughbred. To be judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences 2'3" or 2'9" at riders' discretion. Not to be combined with any other division.

NOVICE EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at riders' discretion. May be combined with Open Equitation.

OPEN EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2'6" or 2'9" at riders' discretion. May be combined with Novice Equitation.

LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2' and 2'3" at the rider's discretion. May be combined with HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER.

HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2'6" or 3' at the riders

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Jumps to be 2' or 2'3" at riders' discretion. See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions. time allowed will be generous (350m/min) May be combined with HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPERS

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Jumps to be 2'6" or 3' at riders' discretion. See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions. time allowed will be generous (350m/min) May be combined with LOW SCHOOLING JUMPERS

OUTSIDE COURSE

The course will be open for schooling up until start time. In case of wet footing these classes will run in the white ring after the High Schooling Hunters. A Champion and Reserve ribbon will be awarded to the horse/rider combination accumulating the most points in classes #105-109.

OPEN HUNTER OVER FENCES

Open to adults and juniors on horses or ponies to be ridden on an outside course over natural fences at a safe hunting pace. Fence heights optional 2' or 2'6".

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adults or juniors to show under saddle at a walk, trot, and canter.

HANDY HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adults or juniors. May be asked to perform certain tasks associated with the hunting field such as trotting fences, dropping rails, etc. to be shown over a modified handy hunter course, heights optional.

HUNTER PAIRS

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden tandem, changing position at a posted position on the course. Fence heights optional 2' or 2'9".

HUNT TEAMS

Open to horses/ponies, tandem over the first part of the course, and abreast over the last two fences. Heights optional 2' or 2'9".
